PROGRAMS

City Camp: Serves economically disadvantaged children from greater Indianapolis. The week-long camp costs \$60 for children who qualify. Children receive three home-cooked meals, 24-hour supervision, a child-counselor ratio of eight-to-two and round-trip transportation. Camp is held five times each summer.

Asthma Camp: In existence for 20 years, this session is staffed by over 20 medical volunteers, including doctors, respiratory therapists, nurses and pharmacists. The goal of this camp is to educate children with asthma on how to remain active while controlling their medical condition.

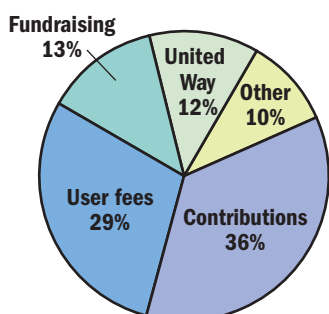
