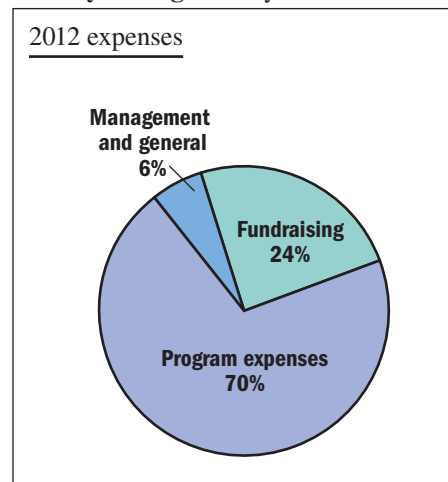
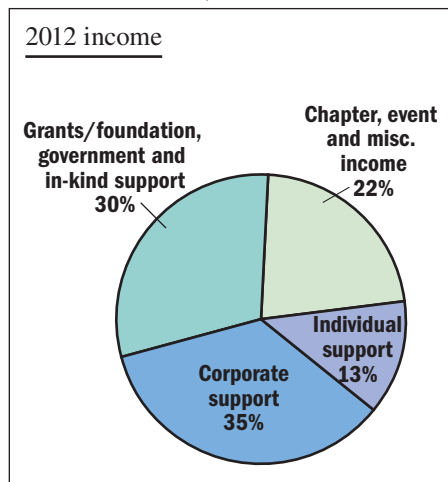
FUNDRAISER
