Education and child care: Eight early-care and education centers in central Indiana improve education outcomes for children birth to age 5. The Tuition Assistance Program makes quality care and education affordable to all children and families by offering financial assistance. Child Care Answers is a community and corporate resource and referral program that serves more than 10,000 families annually with a provider database of more than 3,000 contacts.

Training: Credential classes, workshops and mentoring programs are offered to community child care providers, registered ministries and Day Nursery staff to lead them toward certification, licensure and accreditation.
