PROGRAMS

Community services: The Hands UP Staffing program helps individuals with barriers to employment increase their skills and education and set employment goals. A food pantry and hot meal program provides more than 70,000 meals a year. A thrift store offers free gently used clothing and household items throughout the year, and a Christmas shopping program gives families a place to select new toys, clothing, blankets and food. Golden Age luncheons are held monthly from September-May to engage senior neighbors in fellowship, food and Bingo.

Educational services: A preschool program is offered for children ages 3-5 from extremely low-income families to help successfully prepare them for kindergarten. A twice-a-week tutoring program prepares adults for the GED test. Art in The City gives area youth an artistic outlet during school breaks.

FUNDRAISER

A \$10 Kroger gift card provided entry to “Culinary Collage: Take a Bite Out of Poverty” on April 27. The event, which raised \$21,500, featured food samples from local restaurants, a live animal show, music, a silent auction, raffles and a door prize.
