PROGRAMS

Basic and engagement services: At Horizon House, the homeless receive access to safe day shelter, laundry and shower facilities, food, clothing, help securing identification and personal documents, and referrals to critical services including housing relocation and stabilization assistance. An on-site health center offers medical and mental health care. Indiana Legal Services provides legal consultation and representation for civil cases.

Employment services: The homeless receive job training as well as job search and retention skills. Professional resume and online job search assistance is available, as is transportation.

Street outreach services: Horizon House coordinates the city-wide Professional Blended Street Outreach initiative among 17 organizations and more than 43 outreach workers. The unsheltered homeless receive basic survival supplies and can connect to individuals with additional services to reduce barriers to housing.

FUNDRAISER

The annual Tackling Homelessness event celebrates the success of people who have overcome homelessness and shows support for those who are most in need. About \$165,000 was raised at the event in September.
