PROGRAMS

Policy advocacy: Spearheaded Indiana's 2009 electronics recycling law, championed the state's newly established goal of 50 percent recycling, and is building support for increased state funding for recycling infrastructure.

Educational outreach: Works with schools to promote Recycle-Bowl and RecycleMania and manages the Project ReDirectory telephone book recycling competition.

Recycling support and resources: The Lend-A-Bin program provides containers for event recycling. Serves as a portal to local recycling resources across Indiana.

Recycling Job Study: A 2013 study commissioned by IRC showed that recycling just 25% of what we dispose today would create 10,000 additional jobs while delivering much needed materials to 77 Indiana manufacturers that use recycled feedstock in their processes.

FUNDRAISER

IRC's annual conference and trade show raised \$73,000 last May. The REVENT gala in November raised \$33,000.
