PROGRAMS

Recycling services: RecycleForce specializes in recycling electronic waste but also offers collection of plastic, aluminum, paper and cardboard. All services are low or no cost and many donations qualify for tax benefits.

Workforce training: With funds generated through recycling, RecycleForce provides temporary employment and other comprehensive services designed to help formerly incarcerated individuals get their lives back on track. Program participants receive an integrated focus on jobs skills, character development and personal counseling. This approach greatly increases the chance of sustained future employment and decreases recidivism. Working with industry partners and employers committed to hiring ex-offenders, RecycleForce helps facilitate the transition from temporary work to full-time, gainful employment.

FUNDRAISER

Funds are raised through community recycling events including a post-Christmas event, Warrick County Recycling Day and Hinkle Fieldhouse Collection Day.
