PROGRAMS

Helping teachers help kids: Since 2000, Teachers' Treasures has distributed more than \$35 million worth of free school supplies. Businesses, individuals and The Kids in Need Foundation donate materials for teachers to use in their classrooms. Nearly 2,700 Indianapolis-area teachers from school districts with 40 percent or more of the student population on free or reduced lunch programs are eligible to participate. For a small annual fee, teachers can "shop" once a month throughout the school year in a free retail-like supply store. Over 100,000 students benefit from the program annually.
