## PROGRAMS

**Residential summer camp:** Seven week-long sessions of residential summer camp are offered to primarily low-income youth ages 7-17. The camps specialize in serving youth with minor social, emotional or behavioral challenges, as well as those affected by HIV/AIDS.

**Youth leadership:** Throughout the year, teens learn leadership skills like effective communication, respect, responsibility, teamwork, organization and community service.

**Outdoor education:** A greater appreciation and understanding of nature is promoted through environmental education experiences. Programming is offered year-round to schools, scouts and rental groups. Activities include hiking, identifying plants and wildlife, and studying at a learning pond and weather station.

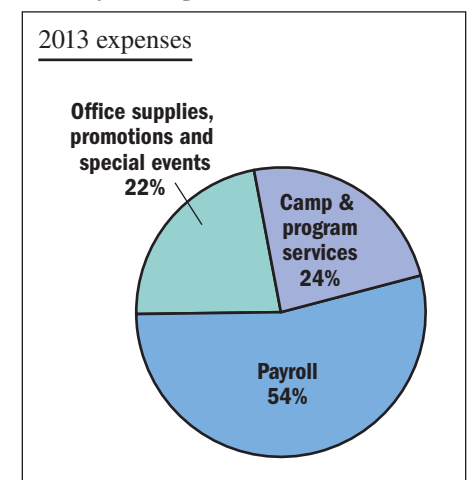
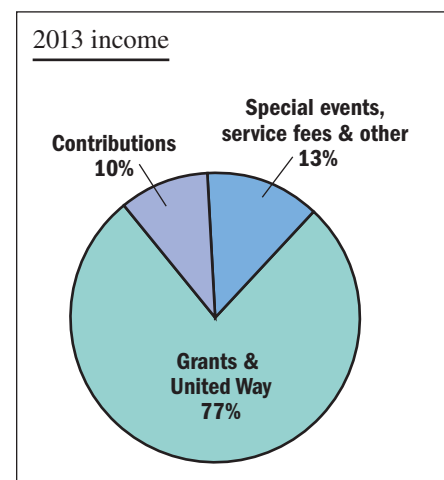
## FUNDRAISER
